

The 13th Post-Graduate Diploma Course of UN-CSSTEAP completed at PRL

The thirteenth Post-Graduate Diploma course in Space and Atmospheric Science (SAS) conducted by Physical Research Laboratory (PRL), Ahmedabad was successfully concluded on 31 May 2024. The valedictory function took place in SAC.

PRL conducts this 9-months course every alternate year under the aegis of the Centre for Space Science and Technology Education in Asia and the Pacific (CSSTE-AP), which is affiliated to the United Nations. The purpose of this course is to impart knowledge and technical skills in space and atmospheric sciences for participants from the Asia-Pacific region so that they can use it for the socio-economic benefit of their home countries.

So far 144 students from 17 countries (Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Korea DPR, Kyrgyzstan, Lao PDR, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Vietnam) have been benefited by participating in the PG Diploma courses over the last 25 years. The first such course was conducted by PRL in 1998.

Over the years, PRL has also conducted many short courses, in-person and online, of one-to-two weeks duration related to Space Sciences, more particularly in the field of Space Weather, Solar Physics, and Planetary Science.
